

Roof Cleaning Process

Preparing Your Home



- Sensitive plants are covered using a light weight painters tarp.
- They are watered down prior to tarping.
- After the roof section is completed, the tarp is rinsed and removed. The plant is rinsed again.

Downspouts & Run-off

- Downspouts channel the solution and discharges it in a larger volume than if it was evenly dispersed.
- This allows a capture of about 1 to 2 gallons of solution depending on your roof and solution used.



Usage of Tarps



- Tarping of AC or pool heating units is an important step of care to prevent the solution from entering the interior components of the unit when gutters are not present.

Plant Care

- When the solution is applied to the roofs surface, it gives off a fine mist when sprayed.
- This is the reason for rinsing down the leaves of the plants.
- Plant damage can occur if not rinsed down.
- Most damage occurs at the leaves not the actual root system.
- Damage to plants is a rarity and irresponsible.

Application Process

- Specialized equipment allows an evenly distributed spray to coat the roof material with the cleaning solution.
- The solution applied is best left until a good rainfall to achieve longer lasting results



Final Rinsing Step

- When no gutters are existing, a final rinsing may be required. This is usually done when there is sensitive equipment or plants below the gutter line.
- Typically the rinsing is done about 4-5 feet of the lower rows of the roof.
- This is the best maintenance practices that allow for optimal results.
